As Evis Zenios concluded his seminar on the 'Future of Monday' last week at Columbia Plaza Venue Center in Limassol, no one moved.

There was no springing up from their seats and dashing for the door as is usually the case with most brain-twisting seminars.

Everyone sat still, taking in the information Evis shared, pondering on their, and most importantly, their children's future in a world already dominated by such notions as Fintech, digital assets, blockchains, security tokens, BlockFi, the Metaverse and a plethora of other technology-based innovations that seem to have been transported into today from the distant future.

They were simply left in awe.

The seminar was organised by the Cyprus Fiduciary Association (CYFA) on Thursday, 1 December 2022, and attracted an eclectic crowd of high technology professionals, accountants, lawyers, business people and even doctors.

Evis, an MIT graduate and a well-known entrepreneur in the high technology field in Cyprus, started his seminar with an introduction to traditional payment methods, how those evolved into paper money and finally to digital currencies.

He then focused on how today's technologies are evolving at such a high rate that the 'future is yesterday'. He then talked about utilities like Day by Day insurance services that sit on Algorand, NFTs on XRPL, the further development of Bitcoin and Ethereum, Green Blockchains like Stellar and Celo, Genesis, Web3.0, the new Phygital environment and much more.

At the end of the interactive seminar, Evis advised everyone to study the technology before attempting to invest in cryptocurrencies, to always have a long-term plan and only invest what they can afford.
